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CIRCULAR

Circular regarding SOP for allotment & allocation of CRMI to FMGs in UT of J&K

The Jammu & Kashmir Medical Council (JKMC) keeps on receiving several representations from Foreign Medical Graduates (FMGs) requesting reduction of the duration of Clerkship/Compulsory Rotating Medical Internship (CRMI) from two/three years to one/two years.

In this regard, it is hereby informed that the Council processes every application strictly in accordance with the applicable Regulations, Guidelines, Public Notices, Clarifications, and directions issued by the National Medical Commission (NMC). Each case is examined individually on its own merits and the applicable regulatory framework before an appropriate decision is taken by the Council in its duly convened meetings.

With a view to ensuring transparency, consistency, objectivity, and uniformity in the processing of such applications, and to facilitate strict compliance with the applicable directions of the NMC, the JKMC follows a Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for scrutiny and processing of applications submitted by FMGs for grant of Provisional Registration to undergo Clerkship/CCRMI which is reproduced below for the information of FMGs:

A: Introduction: This policy is framed for applicability and allocation of CRMI to FMGs in J&K in accordance with:

1. National Medical Commission (NMC) Act, 2019
2. CRMI Regulations, 2021
3. Foreign Medical Graduate Licentiate (FMGL) Regulations, 2021
4. Screening Test Regulations, 2002 (for pre-2021 admissions)
5. Applicable NMC Public Notices
 - a. Dated 28-07-2022
 - b. Dated 22-11-2023
 - c. Dated 07-12-2023
 - d. Dated 07-06-2024
 - e. Dated 19-06-2024
 - f. Clarifications of public notice dated 19-06-2024 issued on 07-08-2025
 - g. Dated 18-03-2026
 - h. Dated 08-06-2026

B: Applicability: This policy shall apply to all the FMGs in J&K who:

1. Who comes under the Screening Test Regulations 2002
2. Have obtained a primary medical qualification from a foreign institution
3. Have qualified FMGE
4. Have qualified NEET or have obtained Eligibility Certificate from MCI/NMC
5. Are seeking provisional registration for CRMI in J&K

C: FMGs with fully Offline MBBS and who have done one-year CRMI from China, Nepal & Bangladesh and other countries whose MBBS duration is equivalent to India and their onsite internship is considered valid by NMC: No CRMI to be done. Issue direct permanent registration after verification of degree, internship, 12th, Passport/VISA stamps and NBEMS scorecard.

D: FMGs with 'fully Offline MBBS from countries whose MBBS duration is equivalent to India but have NOT done onsite CRMI: Shall be required to undergo one (1) year of CRMI in India.

E: FMGs who have done penultimate and/or final year of their MBBS in online mode and have NOT done Compensation or have done inadequate compensation: FMGs who have attended online classes during their penultimate and/or final years and have not done compensation or the compensation certificates submitted by them has been rejected after scrutiny by the Council shall be required to undergo one (1) or two (2) years of Clerkship, as applicable followed by one (1) year of CRMI in India. **(Annexure A)**

F: FMGs who have done penultimate and/or final year of their MBBS course in online mode and have submitted a 'valid' Compensation Certificate: FMGs who have attended online classes (penultimate and/or final years) but possess a valid Compensation Certificate issued by the same parent foreign medical institution and have done one year of CRMI shall be given direct permanent registration. The "compensation" shall be verified by following checks after receipt of '**Annexure B & C**' from FMGs:

1. The period of their on-site 'compensation' should align with the time period of their online study. For this purpose, "sufficiently" means 75% of their pre-final and/or final year course time excluding vacations. For this purpose, Council has formally sought official vacation duration from foreign Universities/Institutions. Minor shortage in attendance may be condoned after case-to-case review by the full Council review.
2. Any portion of penultimate and/or final year of a medical course completed by a FMG via online mode must be compensated through physical, onsite training (including additional classes, and/or extended course duration) to meet the primary objective that is to ensure that FMGs acquire the requisite practical and clinical competencies through adequate physical training.
3. The adequacy of compensation shall be determined by examining the compensation certificate, transcript of record, internship records and any other relevant documents issued by the parent foreign medical institution. The focus of such verification shall be on ensuring that the requisite practical and clinical competencies have been acquired through physical on-site training.
4. In cases where a separate transcript record is not available, the staff may examine alternative academic documents issued by the parent foreign medical institution containing relevant academic and training details. The sufficiency and acceptability of such documents shall be determined by the concerned staff on the basis of the facts and documents available in each case.
5. The time spent for compensation must be examined along with passport/VISA records to establish 'on-site' presence of FMG during compensation.
6. The compensation certificate must be signed and stamped by the Head of the Institution/University that has issued the MBBS degree.
7. The compensation certificate must be duly attested and verified by the Indian Embassy/High Commission.
8. Each case shall be considered on its own merits based on documentary verification of submitted documents.
9. In case an application fails the above checks, the claim for compensation to be rejected and appropriate clerkship/CRMI to be issued as per **Annexure A**.



G: Documents Required for grant of Provisional Registration: The following documents shall be submitted in original for physical verification.

1. MBBS Degree Certificate/Equivalent Qualification (Duly attested by the Indian High Commission/Embassy or Apostilled in that country)
2. Mark sheets/Academic Transcripts of all professional years (Duly attested by the Indian High Commission/Embassy)
3. Class 10th Marks Certificate
4. Class 12th Marks Certificate
5. Class 10th Passing Certificate/Diploma
6. Class 12th Passing Certificate/Diploma
7. FMGE Passing Certificate
8. Eligibility Certificate/NEET Qualification Certificate
9. Aadhaar Card (Copy)
10. Passport (Original)
 - a. A self-attested copy of the complete passport (including blank pages) must be submitted
 - b. All pages of the passport must be clearly legible with relevant visa/immigration stamps
 - c. Passports with torn, damaged, or smudged pages shall not be accepted
 - d. In case a new passport is furnished after the old passport is lost:
 - i. FIR/Police report stating the loss of passport must be submitted
 - ii. The case shall be referred to the Health & Medical Education (H&ME) department for immigration verification through the Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA)
11. Travel History Details as per **Annexure B** (duly filled and signed by the FMG)
12. Affidavit (in original), duly attested by a 1st Class Magistrate as per format (**Annexure D**)

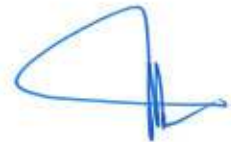

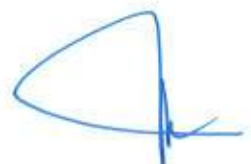
