ORDER

Subject: Withdrawal of Registration/Territorial Permission Granted to Dr. Syed Mateen S/O Syed Sultan R/O 2-6-41, First Floor, Flat No. 106, Sabas Exotica, Opposite Omar Osman Residency, Upper Pally, Rajendranagar, K.V. Rangareddy, Telangana – 500030, on the Strength of “No Objection Certificate” issued by the Telangana Medical Council, on account of misrepresentation of Specialist credentials, facilitation of unauthorised medical practice, and unlawful handling of Narcotic/Psychotropic Medicines

Whereas, Dr. Syed Mateen S/O Syed Sultan holds his Primary Registration with the Telangana State Medical Council, being registered thereunder as Final Registration No. 41798 dated 05.10.1998, on the strength of his MBBS qualification (Karnataka University, Dharwad, June 1998);

Whereas, Dr. Syed Mateen does not hold, and has never sought, an independent Primary Registration with this Council; his permission to practise within the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir was sought and obtained solely on the strength of and in reliance upon a “No Objection Certificate” bearing Ref. No. TGMC/NOC/41798/8815717/2025 issued by the Telangana Medical Council on 10.04.2025 — Standing on Borrowed Ground; that on the strength of the said “No Objection Certificate”, Jammu and Kashmir State Medical Council granted Registration to Dr. Syed Mateen bearing Registration No. 21630 dated 16.05.2025, generated at Jammu, recording his qualification as MBBS (Al-Ameen Medical College, Bijapur, Karnataka University, June 1998) and his permanent address as House No. 10-2-289/115, Flat No. 302, NCL Kaveri-I Apartments, Vijay Nagar Colony;

Whereas, the said “No Objection Certificate” was issued by the Telangana Medical Council expressly and solely upon the representation that no disciplinary proceedings are on record against Dr. Syed Mateen, and certified him only in respect of his Final (MBBS) Registration No. 41798 — a representation that Jammu and Kashmir State Medical Council was entitled to, and did, rely upon as the foundation for permitting Dr. Syed Mateen to practise within this Union Territory;

Whereas, it is a well-settled principle that permission, facility, or extension of registration granted expressly upon a specified representation subsists only for so long as that representation continues to hold true, and stands liable to be withdrawn, without more, upon the said representation being shown to be false or no longer capable of being sustained; such withdrawal is administrative in character and does not partake of a disciplinary or punitive proceeding, since nothing is thereby taken away from the

practitioner otherwise than in accordance with the very terms upon which it was granted to him in the first place;

The Foundational Representation Has Failed:

Whereas, what is disclosed on the record in the present case is not a mere technical lapse but a sustained Scheme of Misrepresentation and Facilitation of Quackery: Dr. Syed Mateen permitted himself to be projected as a Specialist Psychiatrist and Clinic In Charge in the complete absence of any such Registration with Jammu and Kashmir State Medical Council, functioning in tandem with, and lending the colour of medical legitimacy to, an establishment that simultaneously procured and dispensed narcotic/psychotropic medicines — in huge, commercial quantities — in the name of Dr. Ambaliya Chirag Sanjaybhai, a person holding no medical registration of any description, whatsoever, and that permitted the establishment's Non-Medical Proprietor, Shri Jasbir Singh, to personally dispense such medicines to patients and to write Clinical Entries in their Treatment Cards and case files, an act reserved exclusively to a Registered Medical Practitioner; that this is not the conduct of a Practitioner who has merely fallen short of the standard expected of him, but the conduct of one who allowed his own borrowed and misrepresented credentials to be used as the instrument by which unauthorised and unregistered persons were enabled to procure, handle, and sell Scheduled Narcotic/Psychotropic Substances to vulnerable patients under a false appearance of medical supervision, in flagrant violation of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 and the ethical obligations owed by every Registered Medical Practitioner;

Whereas, Jammu and Kashmir State Medical Council has before it a signed statutory Order of the Office of the Chief Medical Officer, Jammu, passed in exercise of its powers as the District Registering Authority under the Clinical Establishments (Registration and Regulation) Act, 2010, namely the Order dated 06.04.2026 (Divine De-Addiction Centre, Opposite Wave Mall, Vidata Nagar, NH-44, Jammu), which records specific and unambiguous findings that Dr. Syed Mateen was projected, and held himself out, as associated with the said establishment in a Clinical Capacity notwithstanding that he is not registered with Jammu and Kashmir State Medical Council as a Psychiatrist, and that Affidavits were submitted in his name before a First Class Magistrate on 11.04.2025 asserting that he is "In Charge of" the said Clinical Establishment, that he would dispense Buprenorphine and Tapentadol to patients and record the same in Patients' Treatment Cards/Case Files, and that he would function as Clinic In Charge; that the said Order further records that Shri Jasbir Singh, the Non-Medical Proprietor of the establishment, submitted his own sworn affidavits before a First Class Magistrate in which he affirmed, in terms that leave no room for ambiguity, that he "will... dispense Buprenorphine and Tapentadol tablets to the needy patients and shall record in patients treatment card/case file", that longer take-home doses "will be given only after I am convinced about the genuine and unavailability of the situation", and that he "will maintain dispensing records of all psychotropic drugs" — undertakings by a wholly non-medical person to personally perform functions of prescription, clinical judgment, and case record entry that are reserved exclusively to a Registered Medical Practitioner;

Whereas, Jammu and Kashmir State Medical Council's own verification, communicated to the Chief Medical Officer, Jammu, Vide Letter No. JKMC/J/2026/10404-05 dated 24.03.2026, and the said Order dated 06.04.2026, have independently confirmed that the Qualification and Clinical Capacity so asserted by and

projected for Dr. Syed Mateen do not correspond to any valid MD-Psychiatry Registration held by him with Jammu and Kashmir State Medical Council, and that no such Post-Graduate/Specialist Qualification of his has ever been placed upon this Council's Register; that he has, notwithstanding, throughout been projected, and has held himself out, as a Specialist Psychiatrist and Clinic In Charge on the strength of the aforesaid "No Objection Certificate" referable only to his primary MBBS Registration, the underlying representation of Specialist/Psychiatric Qualification never having been placed on or verified by this Council's Register; that this Council's said verification dated 24.03.2026 further confirms, in respect of Dr. Ambaliya Chirag Sanjaybhai who was also associated with the establishments concerned, that he is registered with this Council neither as MD Psychiatry, nor as MBBS, nor in any other capacity whatsoever — a matter of even graver import, dealt with in fuller detail below;

Whereas, Jammu and Kashmir State Medical Council regards it as a matter of particular gravity that the establishment concerned was, at the material time, also associated with one Dr. Ambaliya Chirag Sanjaybhai, who is not registered with this Council in any capacity whatsoever — holding neither a valid MBBS Registration nor an MD Psychiatry Registration with this Council, and being, in point of fact, a person wholly unknown to this Council's Register; that notwithstanding this complete want of any registration, Dr. Ambaliya Chirag Sanjaybhai was projected as a Specialist Psychiatrist and Person-in-Charge of the establishments concerned by way of sworn affidavits dated 17.08.2024 and 22.08.2024 before a First Class Magistrate; that substantial quantities of Narcotic/Psychotropic Medicines — including Buprenorphine 2.0mg/Naloxone 0.5mg sublingual tablets and Tapentadol preparations, running to several hundred boxes and several thousand tablets across successive tax invoices (illustratively, invoices dated 31.08.2024 and 30.08.2024 of Rusan Pharma Ltd., and invoice dated 10.05.2025 of Ethicare Pharmaceuticals Pvt. Ltd.) — were procured and sold from the said establishments against his name, and thereafter dispensed to patients, notwithstanding that he holds no registration of any kind entitling him to prescribe, procure, store, or dispense any medicine whatsoever, let alone a Scheduled Narcotic/Psychotropic substance; that this Council regards the sustained procurement and sale of controlled Narcotic/Psychotropic medicines in the name of a person who is not, and has never been, registered with this Council in any capacity as a circumstance graver still than the misrepresentation of a Specialist Qualification, since it discloses that the establishments concerned were, at material times, functioning under cover of an entirely fictitious medical identity rather than under any genuine registration however deficient; that Dr. Syed Mateen was, on the same premises and during overlapping periods, similarly projected as a Psychiatrist, and that Tax Invoices on record (including Invoice No. 810007380 dated 30.06.2025 of Rusan Pharma Ltd., raised upon Divine De-Addiction Centre, Opp. Wave Mall, NH-44, Jammu, recording the Contact Person as "Dr. Syed Mateen Reg. 41798") disclose the further procurement of 36,000 Buprenorphine 2.0mg/Naloxone 0.5mg sublingual tablets against Dr. Syed Mateen's own registration number, notwithstanding that no Specialist Psychiatric Qualification of his stood registered with this Council authorising such procurement, prescription, or supervision of narcotic/psychotropic substances; that the establishments concerned thus disclose a rotating and inter-changeable use of borrowed, misrepresented, and wholly fictitious medical identities — of Dr. Syed Mateen, of Dr. Ambaliya Chirag Sanjaybhai, and of others — as a device to obtain and retain the appearance of medical supervision while none such existed in fact;

Whereas, this Council regards it as material, and as going to the very root of the matter, that Shri Jasbir Singh, the Non-Medical Proprietor of the establishments concerned, has by his own sworn affidavits dated 20.05.2024, 22.04.2025 and

29.05.2025 before a First Class Magistrate, personally and directly undertaken clinical functions reserved exclusively by law to a duly qualified and Registered Medical Practitioner — namely, to dispense Buprenorphine and Tapentadol tablets to patients, to determine and authorise longer take-home doses upon being personally “convinced about the genuineness and unavoidability of the situation”, and, critically, to record and write the same in Patients' Treatment Cards/Case Files; that the writing of Clinical Entries in a Patient's Treatment Card or Case File is not a ministerial or administrative act but an act of clinical judgment falling within the exclusive domain of a Registered Medical Practitioner, and that its undertaking by Shri Jasbir Singh — a person possessing no Medical Qualification or Registration of any kind — constitutes, on its own and independent of the credentials-misuse addressed above, a direct and unambiguous act of impersonation of medical authority and Unauthorised Medical Practice (Quackery), as this Council's verification dated 24.03.2026 has itself characterised such conduct; that Dr. Syed Mateen, by projecting himself as Clinic-In-Charge of an establishment which he knew, or ought to have known, was in fact being run on a day-to-day clinical basis by Shri Jasbir Singh in this manner, lent the cover of his own (Misrepresented) Medical Credentials to, and thereby directly facilitated, this Practice of Quackery;

Whereas, this Council accordingly records that the foundational representation upon which permission to practise within this Union Territory was extended to Dr. Syed Mateen no longer subsists, and has, upon the facts now on record, failed;

Whereas, it is material to record that the failure of the foundational representation is not an extraneous or adventitious circumstance visited upon Dr. Syed Mateen by the conduct of a third party; the very findings which falsify that representation are findings recorded against him by name in a signed statutory Order of the Office of the Chief Medical Officer, Jammu. This Council further notes, with the gravest concern, that the very establishment at which Dr. Syed Mateen was projected as Person-in-Charge — Divine De-Addiction Centre, Opposite Wave Mall, Vidata Nagar, NH-44, Jammu — was, in the first instance, placed under SUSPENSION by the Chief Medical Officer, Jammu, Vide Order dated 31.03.2026, for unauthorised use of Medical Credentials and illegal procurement/diversion of Narcotic and Psychotropic Medicines; and that, notwithstanding such suspension and the clear and unambiguous directions accompanying it to cease all operations forthwith, the said establishment continued to operate in willful and brazen disobedience of a lawful order, culminating in the CANCELLATION of its Provisional Registration by the Chief Medical Officer, Jammu, Vide Order dated 06.04.2026 — a sequence of escalating regulatory action which this Council regards as demonstrating, unmistakably, not a solitary or inadvertent lapse but a sustained and defiant continuation of illegal narcotic trade, carried on under cover of Dr. Syed Mateen's borrowed and misrepresented medical identity, even after the establishment stood under formal suspension. No consideration of equity or hardship can accordingly arise in his favour, since the disqualifying fact and its cause are one and the same, and he cannot be heard to claim the benefit of a representation the falsity of which is a direct and foreseeable consequence of his own conduct;

Whereas, this Council considers it necessary to record that the withdrawal ordered below is independently, and urgently, required in the interest of Public Health and Public Safety; the conduct disclosed on this record is not a matter of mere administrative irregularity but one of illegal dispensing of Scheduled Narcotic and Psychotropic Medicines, unauthorised commercial-scale procurement of such substances in the names of Unregistered and Unqualified persons, and the sustained facilitation of quackery whereby dangerous, addiction-forming, and strictly controlled

medicines were placed directly in the hands of, and personally dispensed by, individuals possessing no Medical Qualification or Registration, whatsoever; that establishments of the kind with which Dr. Syed Mateen has been associated treat patients suffering from substance-use disorders, a population that is by its nature vulnerable, dependent upon the controlled substances administered to them, and exposed to grave and immediate risk of overdose, dependence, diversion into illicit channels, and death, where such substances are handled, prescribed, and dispensed outside the continuous and lawful supervision of a duly qualified and registered Specialist Psychiatrist; that this Council will not countenance the continuance, even nominally, of any registration that lends the colour of medical legitimacy to such conduct;

Whereas, this Council clarifies that its own action in the present Order is confined strictly to the withdrawal of the Permission/Territorial Registration granted by it on the strength of the aforesaid "No Objection Certificate"; the question of Professional Misconduct on the part of Dr. Syed Mateen — including his misrepresentation of Specialist Credentials before this Council and before statutory authorities, his facilitation of quackery by a Non-Medical Proprietor and by persons holding no medical registration whatsoever, and his association with the procurement, in huge and commercial quantities, of Narcotic/Psychotropic Medicines in the names of Unauthorised and Unregistered persons, and the consequent dispensing of such medicines to patients without lawful medical supervision — arising from the matters referred to herein is not adjudicated by this Order, and lies, in the first instance, within the disciplinary jurisdiction of the Telangana Medical Council as his Parent Registering Body. This Council accordingly forwards the material referred to herein, including the findings on misrepresentation, facilitation of Quackery, and Unauthorised Commercial-scale procurement and dispensing of Narcotic/Psychotropic Substances, to the Telangana Medical Council for such disciplinary action as that Council may consider appropriate under its own regulatory framework;

Now, therefore, this Council Orders as follows:

1. The Jammu and Kashmir Medical Council MBBS Registration bearing Registration No. 21630, dated 16.05.2025 granted to Dr. Syed Mateen by this Council on the strength of the "No Objection Certificate" bearing Ref. No. TGMC/NOC/41798/8815717/2025 issued by the Telangana Medical Council dated 10.04.2025, is hereby WITHDRAWN with immediate effect, the foundational representation upon which such Registration was granted having failed, and the said Registration having further been obtained and sustained through the projection of specialist/psychiatric credentials never registered with this Council, and through facilitation of unauthorised medical practice as recorded above.
2. Dr. Syed Mateen shall, from the date of this Order, be treated as not holding any valid registration entitling him to practise, or to be projected as a Psychiatrist, Specialist, Clinic In Charge, or in any Clinical or Supervisory capacity, at any clinical establishment within the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir.
3. The material referred to herein, together with a copy of this Order, is hereby directed to be forwarded to the Telangana Medical Council, being the Primary/Parent Registering Authority of Dr. Syed Mateen, for such disciplinary action or other action as that Council may deem fit, on account of misrepresentation of credentials, facilitation of quackery, unlawful medical practice, and the matters recorded above.

4. All District Registering Authorities within the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir are advised to treat any pending or future application for Registration of a Clinical Establishment that projects Dr. Syed Mateen in any Clinical or Supervisory capacity as an application projecting a practitioner who does not presently hold valid registration to practise within this Union Territory.

This order is issued in the interest of patient safety, public health, and the integrity of the medical regulatory framework with the approval of the competent authority.
